**The 2009 Long Term Accommodation Plan was approved by the Board of Trustees on April 28, 2009.**

**The Long Term Accommodation Plan identifies future school accommodation needs based on a review of long term enrolment projections, demographic analyses and municipal housing forecasts.**

**The Board has approved proceeding with the replacement schools for St. Anthony Elementary School, Lester B. Pearson Elementary School and Loyola Catholic Secondary School, as well as a new elementary school for the Vales North area in Brampton.**

**All other projects identified on the Long Term Accommodation Plan are subject to further review by the Board of Trustees and are subject to the availability of capital funding from the Ministry of Education.**

**The year denoted on the Long Term Accommodation Plan is the proposed opening date for future schools.**
