

ENGLISH TESTS FOR POST SECONDARY*

English facility requirements differ from university to university. Different institutions use different assessments for different programs. **Please check with the institution for information on which test they use and how they use it.**

It is highly recommended that students:

- Contact the Admissions at the selected university, or check their Web site prior to registering for the test
- Start this process early (some testing sites fill up quickly)

Who requires the English test for post-secondary?

At the University of Toronto, proof of adequate English facility is required for anyone except for those:

- whose language (i.e., the language learned at home as a child) is English, or
- who have achieved satisfactory academic progress in at least four years of full-time study in an English-language school system located in a country where the dominant language is English
- whose first language is French and who have achieved satisfactory academic progress in at least four years of full-time study in Canada

Since this list of requirements may be different for different universities, check the requirements with the institution of your choice.
