

Hello everyone:

Georgian College's dean of technology Bob Emptage is working with Honda Canada to help them fill 300 jobs at their Alliston manufacturing facility. Honda is interested in both secondary graduates and college students, so I am hoping you can mobilize your connections in the schools.

The ideal employee is a secondary graduate, who is not certain about his/her future, but likely to continue to post-secondary training. If hired, the job would be a 20 month contract. Honda hopes these students would identify a post-secondary pathway during their time and pursue it at the end of the 20 months. They would then be given priority for full time jobs/summer jobs as students or post-secondary grads.

I should have further information about the hiring process later today, and will pass it on. Do you think you can get this into guidance offices etc quickly? Honda hopes for a large applicant pool.
