

CAS Graduation & General Guidelines

1. Each IB student is required to generate a CAS portfolio. This will include your CAS log activity evaluations and other additional materials to enhance your CAS portfolio.
2. All CAS projects have to be pre-approved. Obtain CAS activity proposal forms from your CAS supervisor.
3. Upon completion of each CAS activity a CAS evaluation form must be filled out. It is required that the student, CAS Coordinator and a supervisor of the activity sign the evaluation.
4. A copy of your activity evaluation is to be submitted to your CAS Coordinator upon completion.
5. A minimum of 150 CAS hours must be completed during the junior and senior year of IB.
 - A) **A minimum of 50 CAS hours must be classified as CREATIVITY:**
It is interpreted as imaginatively as possible. It can cover a wide range of arts and the designing and carrying out of service projects.
 - B) **A minimum of 50 CAS hours must be classified as ACTION:**
This includes participation in expeditions, performance of individual and team sports, dance, gymnastics, or aerobics. The only hours that can count require an audience.
 - C) **A minimum of 50 CAS hours must be classified as SERVICE:**
These would include helping others in the form of community or social service. It can also include environmental and international projects.
